INDEPENDENT PROVIDER RESOURCES



CPR/FIRST AID TRAINING

CPR/First Aid courses are offered to anyone who is interested in becoming a certified independent provider/already a certified independent provider.

MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION CERTIFICATION

Classes are offered for Medication Administration Certification Categories I, 2, and 3. Recertification classes are also available.

LEARNING LUNCHES

Each month a Learning Lunch is offered. These lunches offer training on a topic that pertains to the everyday work being done as an independent provider, as well as an opportunity for networking. Lunches are held on the second Thursday, RSVP is required.

DODD PROVIDER CERTIFICATION SUPPORT

Assistance and support is offered to those who are interested in becoming a certified independent provider with the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities.

TRAINING

Independent providers are trained on documentation, billing, submitting claims, and provider compliance once they are certified. Individual specific training in accordance with the ISP is also provided.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Support and technical assistance is offered when billing issues are not able to be resolved by the provider.

ONGOING SUPPORT

Open office hours are held via Zoom quarterly with the Board's Medicaid and Provider Support Specialist. This provides an opportunity for independent providers to connect with the Board and ask questions. Appointments can also be made as needed by the independent provider for ongoing support.

MONTHLY PROVIDER MEETINGS

A monthly meeting is organized with providers who serve in Allen County. These meetings are held on the third Wednesday of the month via Zoom. They offer a platform to network with other providers and to receive communication from the Board on important news or topics.
